HOCHTIEF Energy Management extends cooperation with Continental

CO2 emissions cut by 28,000 tons

HOCHTIEF Energy Management will be supplying the automotive industry supplier Continental with energy and production media for a further five years at its Hanover-Stöcken facility. The two companies have signed a corresponding agreement thus extending their nine-year collaboration. It was agreed that no details of the contract volume would be disclosed.

Since 2001 HOCHTIEF Energy Management has reduced the Hanover facility's energy costs by around 2.6 percent per annum and cut CO2 emissions by roughly 28,000 tons. HOCHTIEF operates and optimizes the automotive industry supplier's energy systems and supplies Production, Research & Development and the facility's administration with resources such as steam, compressed air, room heating, electricity and water. In the last few years the service provider has modernized supply plant and networks, and its operation of the energy technology guarantees Continental maximum security of supply.
