HOCHTIEF Energy Management has won a new contract for energy saving contracting at seven schools in the city of Bremen. In the next ten years, the company will reduce the energy costs at the educational facilities by a total of EUR 319,000 per year. The client is "Sondervermögen Immobilien und Technik der Freien Hansestadt Bremen", represented by Bremer Immobilien mbH. The contract volume was agreed to be kept confidential.

HOCHTIEF guarantees the client cost savings of 35 percent annually over the entire contract period. This figure is achieved through, among others, the upgrading of boiler units, integration of modern building automation systems into the facilities, and optimization of the existing systems. In addition, HOCHTIEF will centrally monitor, control and document energy operations for heating and ventilation systems. The financial savings effect will be paralleled by a reduction of the schools' CO2 emissions by some 1,400 metric tons - approximately 35 percent - annually. HOCHTIEF and its client thus make a valuable contribution to environmental protection.
