HOCHTIEF supplies heat to regional Allgäu Airport near Memmingen

Maintenance and servicing of technical systems and delivery of thermal energy for Germany's youngest airport

HOCHTIEF Energy Management will from now on supply the regional Allgäu Airport near Memmingen with heat. To this effect, the Essen-based energy specialists concluded a 15-year energy supply contracting agreement with Allgäu Airport GmbH & Co. KG. The details of the deal were agreed to be kept confidential.

Under the contract, HOCHTIEF Energy Management will ensure supplies to the airport's property objects and to buildings of other companies on the 144-hectare site. The costs for the delivered heat will be invoiced directly to the tenants. In addition, the service provider will maintain and service the energy systems. Allgäu Airport is Germany's youngest and highest airport. It started operations in June 2007 and handled as many as 170,000 passengers in the first six months.
